Hyperbaric Medicine Team Training

An Introductory Course in Hyperbaric Medicine

Course Description

This 4½ day program focuses on a team approach to patient care in a hyperbaric medicine facility. Academics include currently accepted standards for safe use of hyperbaric oxygen therapy and UHMS accepted indications. The comprehensive curriculum is presented by a faculty of experts. Participants will see both monoplace and multiplace facilities. The program also offers an opportunity to experience pressurization inside a hyperbaric chamber.

Objective

Upon completion of the course, participants should understand hyperbaric patient selection, patient care, and safe chamber operations. *Completion of this course does not constitute certification or credentialing.*

Who Should Attend

Physicians, nurses, respiratory therapists, and technicians. Class limited to first 48 persons who register. Program Director reserves the right to refuse admission to any individual applicant and also reserves the right to deny a certificate of completion to any participant not attending the entire course.

Tuition

\$1025 per person (\$50 discount for online registration)

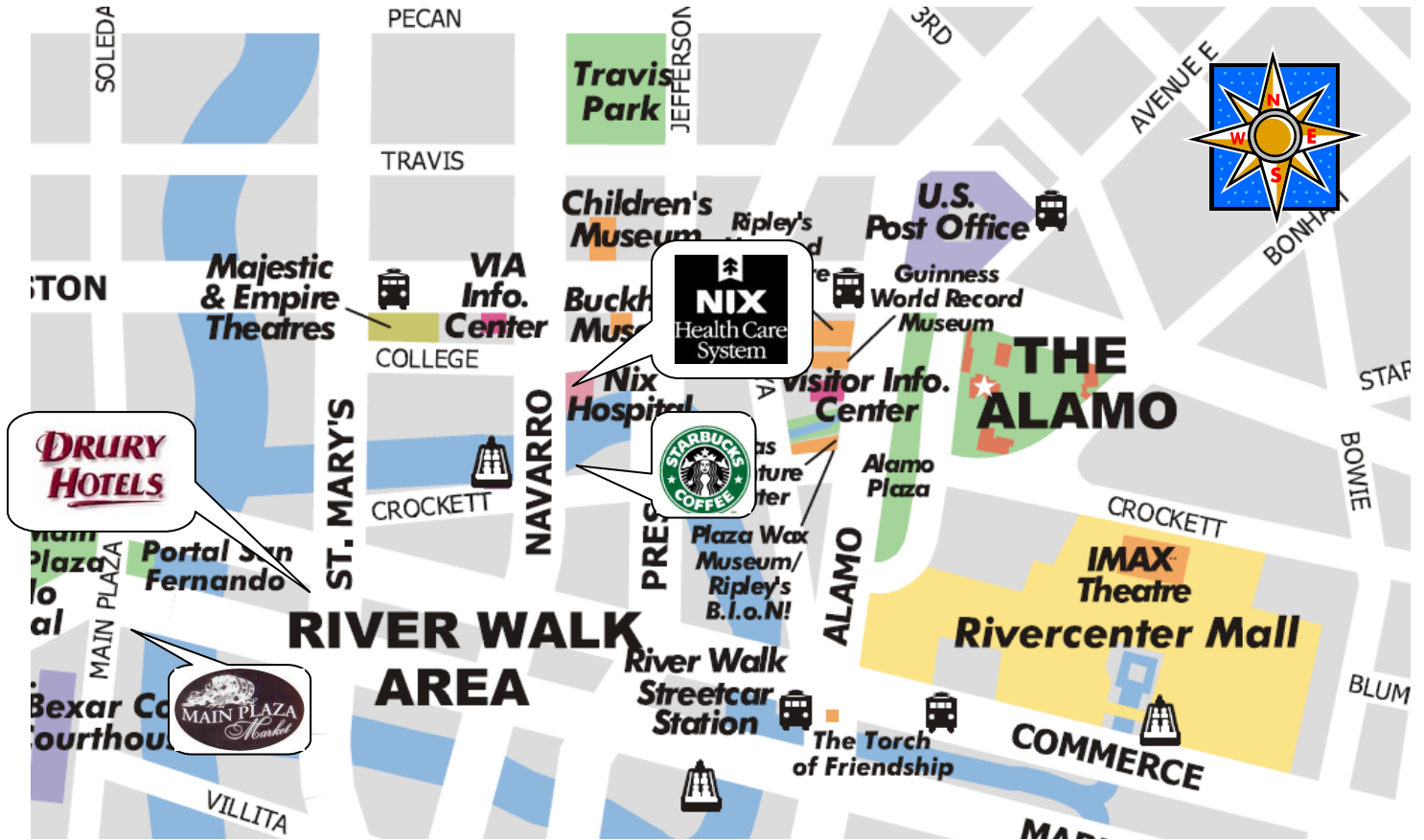
